#### Placing the Mat (umpire's contribution)

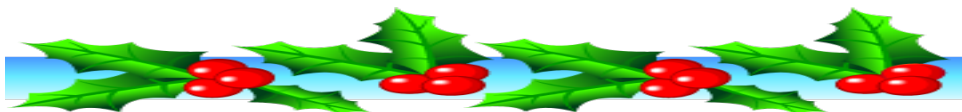
When the jack is incorrectly delivered by the first player to play, her opponent should then roll the jack. Prior to rolling the jack, the opponent may move the mat to a new position should she so wish. If the jack is again incorrectly delivered, the jack is placed on the "T". The first player to play may then move the mat to a new position but the front of the mat must be at least 21 metres from the Jack which is on the ("T"). (Law 19 and Law 23) Thanks to Judy Brady for this information.
