If a Bowl at rest on the rink is in danger of being moved by a bowl from a neighbouring rink, ANY player at the head must choose whether to:

Lift the bowl at rest to allow the other bowl to pass and then replace it as long as this action would not influence the outcome of the head; OR stop the bowl from the neighbouring rink. If that stopped bowl is on the right bias it can be returned and replayed.
