After the start of play in any end

If the mat is displaced, it must be replaced in its original position If the mat is off the centre line, it must be moved to that line If the mat is out of line with the centre line it must be straightened on that line If a player picks up the mat before the end has been completed, an opposing player must replace the mat in its original position.
