SELECTORS REPORT

For social bowls we try hard to get everyone the game you ask for but the numbers mean this is not always possible and we reserve the right to make alterations to the days play list to ensure that (hopefully) everyone gets a game. Please understand that some games may be converted e.g. pairs to triples, triples to pairs, triples to fours. Here are a few reminders

#### TUESDAY BOWLS

You should know and list your special number

You list your desired playing position but we cannot guarantee you that position.

You may add or delete your name by ringing Shirley on 65838127 on Monday evening or by ringing the Bowls office on Tuesday morning between 7.30 and 8am

#### THURSDAY & SATURDAY BOWLS

You may put in a team i.e pairs on Thursday, Triples on Saturday.

If you put in a single entry (at the bottom of the sheet) you should ring 65831153 between 8am and 8.30am on the day of play to confirm if you have a game. We will do our best to include you.

You may add or delete your name or team by ringing Shirley on 65838127 the evening before or by ringing 65831153 between 8am and 8.30am on the morning of play.

**FOR ALL SOCIAL BOWLS** (ie Tuesday, Thursdays, Saturdays) the sheet of names will be taken down on the afternoon before play.

### **UMPIRES CORNER**

**Law 9.** If before a bowl has been played by each team, a player notices that the wrong team has delivered the jack, the correct team will re-start the end.

**Law 9.6** If, after a bowl has been played by each team, a player notices that the wrong team has delivered the jack, play in that end must continue in that order.
