DRESS CODE – SOCIAL BOWLS

All bowlers are expected to be neatly presented when participating in any game of bowls. A person wishing to bowl who does not comply with this requirement will not be permitted on the greens. When playing Social Bowls, bowlers may wear either "bowls uniform" **OR** Neat Casual Dress.

NEAT CASUAL DRESS is defined as follow:

Suitable headwear is **strongly recommended**.

Approved bowls shoes must be worn at all times on the green unless participating in an authorized "barefoot bowls" activity.

Collared shirts must be worn (sleeveless acceptable).

Slacks, cropped pants or knee-length shorts (no tights).

Clothing bearing offensive pictures or motifs is prohibited.

The committee may approve variations to these dress rules for specific occasions.

UMPIRES CORNER

State Pennant – District Pennants - Rulings

3. Matches are to consist of 21 ends per team. NO extra ends to be played. If necessary 2 matches per day may be played. In the event of inclement weather and following appeal, 36 end may constitute a game. The final decision will rest with the venue Controlling Body, NOT THE PLAYERS.

Duties of Pennant Side Managers.

11. Any appeal to the umpire made for inclement weather shall be made by the Managers on behalf of the side. After an appeal the Venue Controlling Body (**not the players**) may decide 36 ends will constitute a Pennant Game.

Women's Bowls NSW – Conditions of play – The Blue Book

16. Only the Controlling Body may abandon play for the day. When this occurs all players must leave the green immediately. Once play has been abandoned for the day it cannot be resumed on the same day.
